Welcome to the second newsletter and report to the public on the work of the Hood/Willamette Resource Advisory Committee (RAC). This committee was formed as a result of P.L. 106-393, The Secure Rural Schools and Communities Self-Determination Act of 2000. The RAC met three times in 2003 to complete their recommendations for Title II projects for Fiscal Year 2004. They considered a total of 178 projects from a variety of groups and agencies. They made recommendations to the Mt. Hood Forest Supervisor, Columbia River Gorge Area Manager, and the Willamette Forest Supervisor on 108 projects totaling \$5.06 million. The meetings included two field trips looking at completed, on-going and proposed Title II projects.
