The Echo Creek culvert has been a barrier to passage of aquatic organisms for years. When Echo Creek was added to a bull trout reintroduction program, the culvert was removed. The area now allows passage of all aquatic organisms and provides bull trout unimpeded access to and from the Middle Fork Willamette River.
